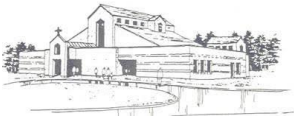

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Lip-Sync Contest Procedures:

1. Each Homeroom will be represented in the contest following a class discussion and auditions. The students will vote to select the best performance to represent their homeroom. This representation may be in the form of;
 - Small student groups
 - The entire class
 - Solo or duet entry
2. Judging will be based upon;
 - Lip-Sync Ability
 - Originality, creativity and choreography
 - Appearance- costumes, props and stage presenceMusic selections are limited to no more than 4 minutes and music must be appropriate, without hidden or alternative meanings. If uncertain ask an adult for assistance.
3. All groups must practice either outside of school or make arrangements with a teacher for any in-school practice time. (During lunch, before or after school). Practices may not take place in school without adult supervision.
4. Once a homeroom has decided on a contest entry, each homeroom teacher will complete a registration form due Wednesday, January 24th to Mrs. Kindred.
5. Small group entries or solo/duets acts will be required to perform a practice session Jan. 25th or 26th.

All Final Contest Entries-Music, Lyrics and Choreography are subject to the approval of the Lip-Sync Committee and must be appropriate for St. Christopher Catholic School.
