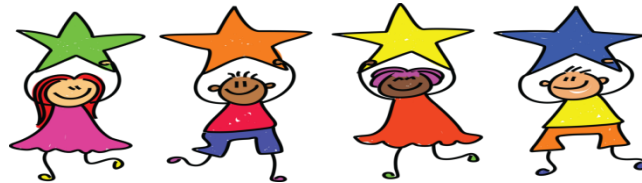

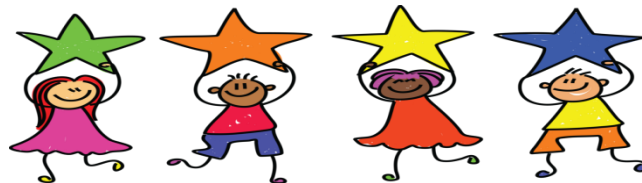


*******Registration for the 2018-2019 School Year*******
